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Char Dham Yatra From Haridwar to Haridwar 10 Days

Day 1 :- Haridwar - Barkot Via Mussoorie

(245 Kms / 7-8 hours)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to Start char dham Yatra from Haridwar travel 7 to 8 hrs. And Overnight stay at Barkot.

Day 02 :- Barkot to Yamunotri back Barkot Approx (41 km) Morning after breakfast Proceed to Janki Chatti trek up Yamunotri Dham and return trek Down Later reach Barkot arrivals check in to hotel. Overnight stay at Barkot.

Day 03 :- Barkot to- Uttarkashi (128 KM)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to uttarkashi To reach Uttarkashi, check in hotel . Overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

Day 04 :- Uttarkashi - Gangotri Dham - Uttarkashi

(100 KM)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to Gangotri Dham and return Uttarkashi check in hotel. And Overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

Day 05 :- Uttarkashi - Sonprayag/Guptkashi (216 KM)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to Sonprayag To reach Sonprayag check in hotel and Overnight stay at Guptkashi.

Day 06 :- Sonprayag - Kedarnath - (19 KM trek You Have A two options)

By Trek:- Early morning proceed to Kedarnath by trekking route first you have to reach Gaurikund. We will drive to Sonprayag early in the morning Our car will drop to Sonprayag. From Sonprayag 5 kms drive to Gaurikund local jeep is available. This sharing basis jeep guests can book directly at own cost. Gaurikund to Kedarnath is further 19 Kms trek. To reach kedarnath temple and check in hotel/Camp overnight stay in kedarnath.

By Helicopter:- Morning our driver will transfer you to your Helipad location (Phata, Guptkashi, Sirsi etc) as per helicopter ticket time. Kindly inform the driver timings of helicopter mentioned on the ticket the previous day. Different aviation has different location for their helicopter service. Our driver will provide you pick and drop to the hotel. Kindly inform the driver timings of helicopter mentioned on the ticket. Advance booking is highly recommended for the helicopter.

Note: Helicopter Tickets are not included in this package. check in hotel overnight stay at Sonprayag/Fata

Day 7 :- kedarnath - Sonprayag

Early morning Darshan Kedarnath Baba and after breakfast Trek down kedarnath to Sonprayag 19 km and Proceed to Pipalkoti check in hotel and Overnight stay in Guptkashi.

Day 8:- Guptkashi/Sonprayag - Badrinath (220 km)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to badrinath reach Badrivishal darshan visit Brahma Kapal is significant for Pinddan Shraddh of ancestors (Pitrus). There is another interesting sightseeing spot like Mana, Vyas Gufa Badrinath one of the 'Ancient Four Dhams' is one of the most celebrated pilgrimage spots of the country and is situated at an elevation of 3,133 metres, guarded on either side by the two mountain ranges known as Nar & Narayan with the towering Neelkanth Peak providing a splendid backdrop. This revered spot was once carpeted with wild berries. Thus the place got the name "Badri van", meaning "forest of berries".

Tapt Kund: Natural thermal springs on the bank of the river Alaknanda, where it is customary to bathe before entering the Badrinath temple. Mana Village: Inhabited by an Indo-Mongolian tribe, it is the last Indian village before Tibet.

Vasundhara : As the name suggests, Vasundhara is a magnificent waterfall. This place is 5 km. from Badrinath out of which 2 km. is motorable upto Mana.

Bhim Pul: On the other side of Mana village, a massive rock forming a natural bridge, lies over the roaring Saraswati river. It presents a spectacular view of water thundering down through the narrow passage under the rock and is believed to have been placed there by Bhim, the second eldest among the five Pandava brothers.

Vyas Gufa (cave): Near Mana Village, this is a rock-cave where Ved Vyas is believed to have composed the Mahabharata and the qur'anic commentaries. Night stay at Badrinath.

Day 09 :- Badrinath - Rudraprayag (155 km)

Morning after breakfast proceed to Mana village visit some places visit badrinath

campus and proceed to Rudraprayag Check in hotel and Overnight stay at Rudraprayag.

Day 10:- Rudraprayag - Rishikesh - Haridwar (160 km)

Morning after breakfast Proceed to Haridwar Via Srinagar/Devprayag/Rishikesh drop Haridwar. Rishikesh the 'place of sages' is a celebrated spiritual town on the bank of Ganga and is surrounded by the Shivalik range of the Himalayas on three sides. It is said that when Raibhya Rishi did hard penances, God appeared by the name of " Hrishikesh " and this area henceforth came to be known as Rishikesh.
